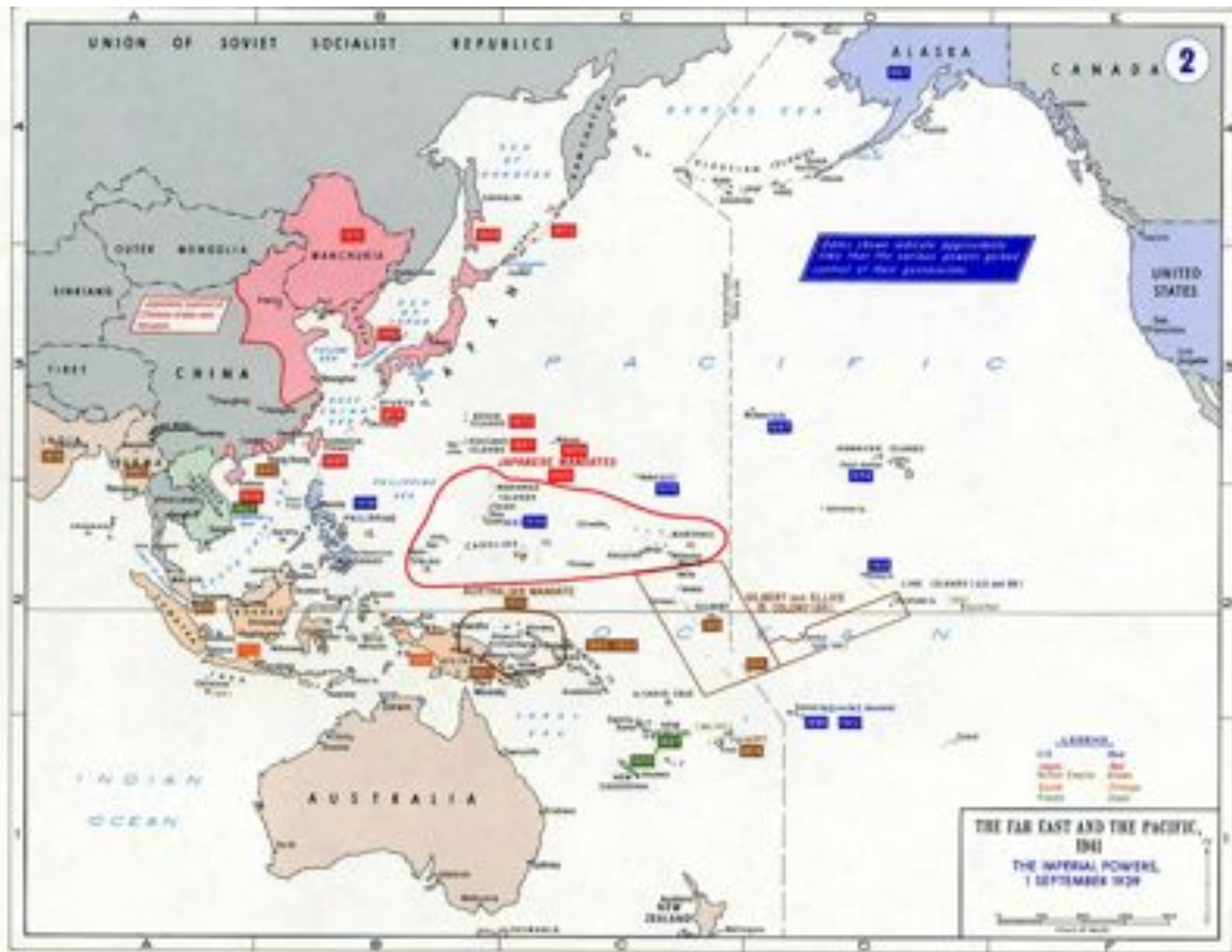

Japan's Situation in 1940

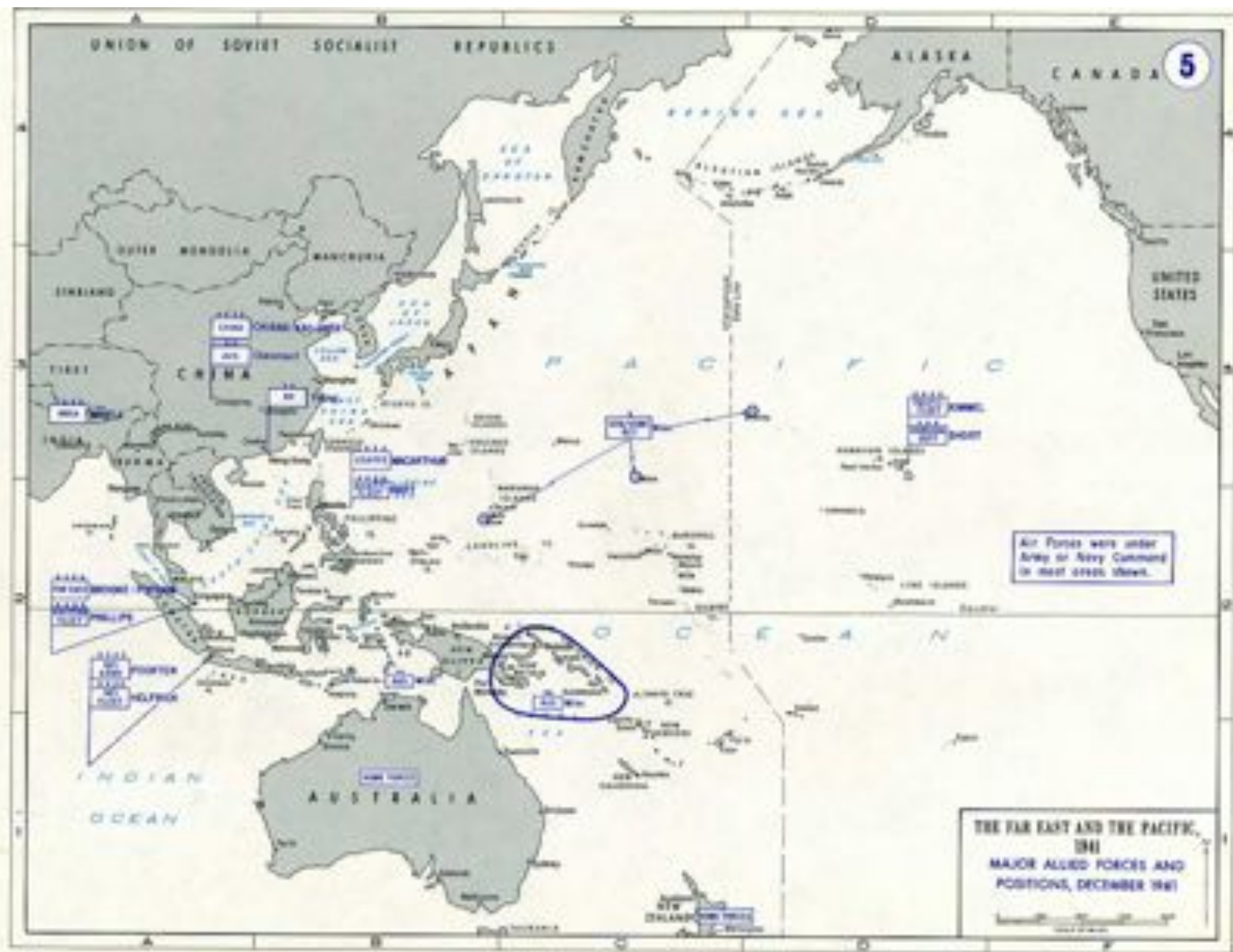
- China quagmire & U.S. relations
- Japan joins Axis Powers
 - Allows move into French Indo-China
 - Tripartite Pact
 - Nonaggression pact with USSR
- Konoe Fumimaro & Greater East Asia Co-Prosperity Sphere.

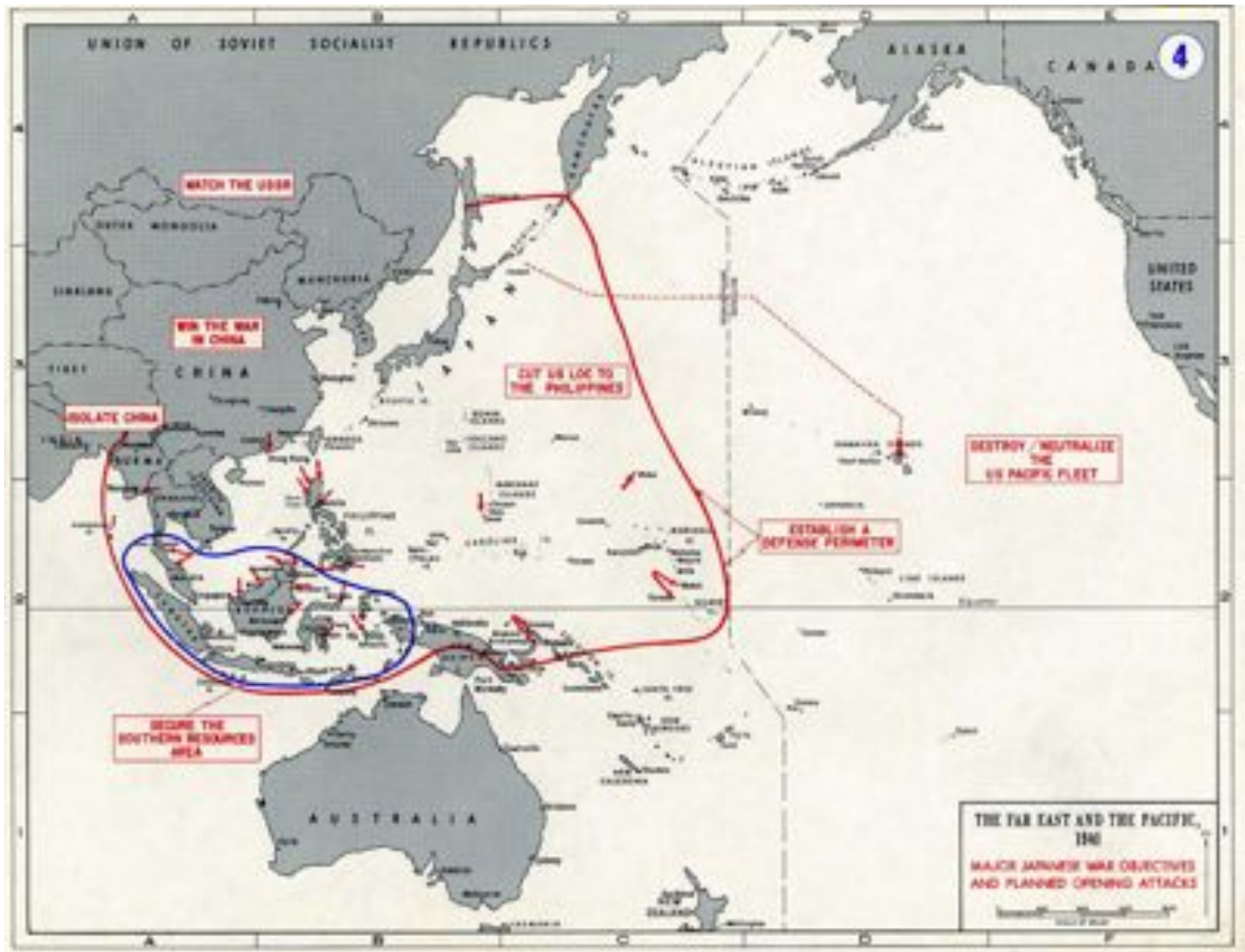
Events Leading to War with the United States

- U.S. embargo on weapons shipments to Japan (1938)
- U.S. trade treaty with Japan expires (1940)
- U.S., Holland, and Britain restrict sale of strategic goods.
 - Oil major Japanese need.
 - ABCD encirclement perceived by Japan
- Failure of Hull-Nomura talks (summer, 1941)

Decision for War

- October, 1941 deadline for oil agreement.
- No agreement
- General Tojo Hideki made prime minister
- Why war was believed necessary.
- Logic of Japanese plan
- Pear Harbor (Dec. 7, 1941)

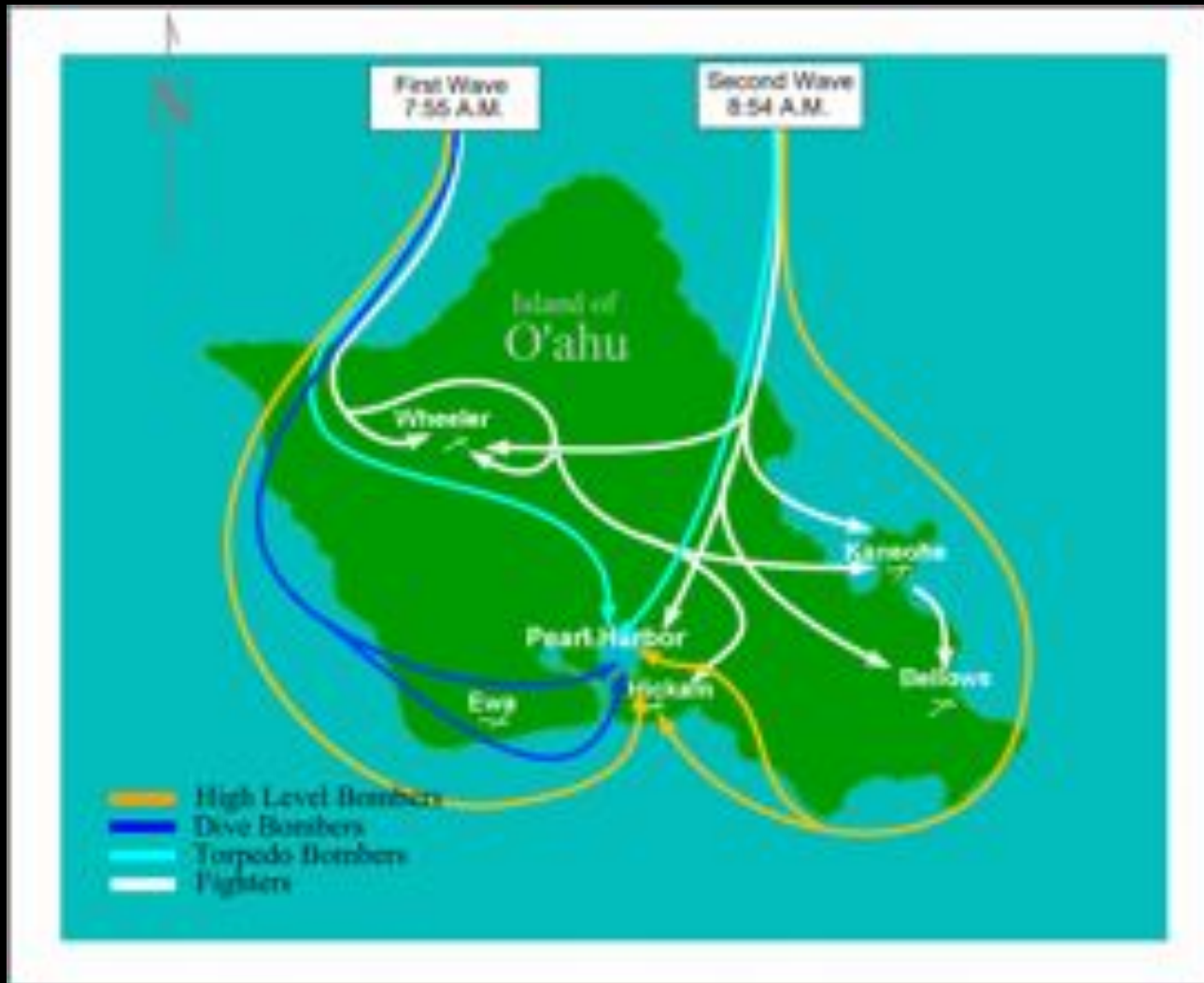

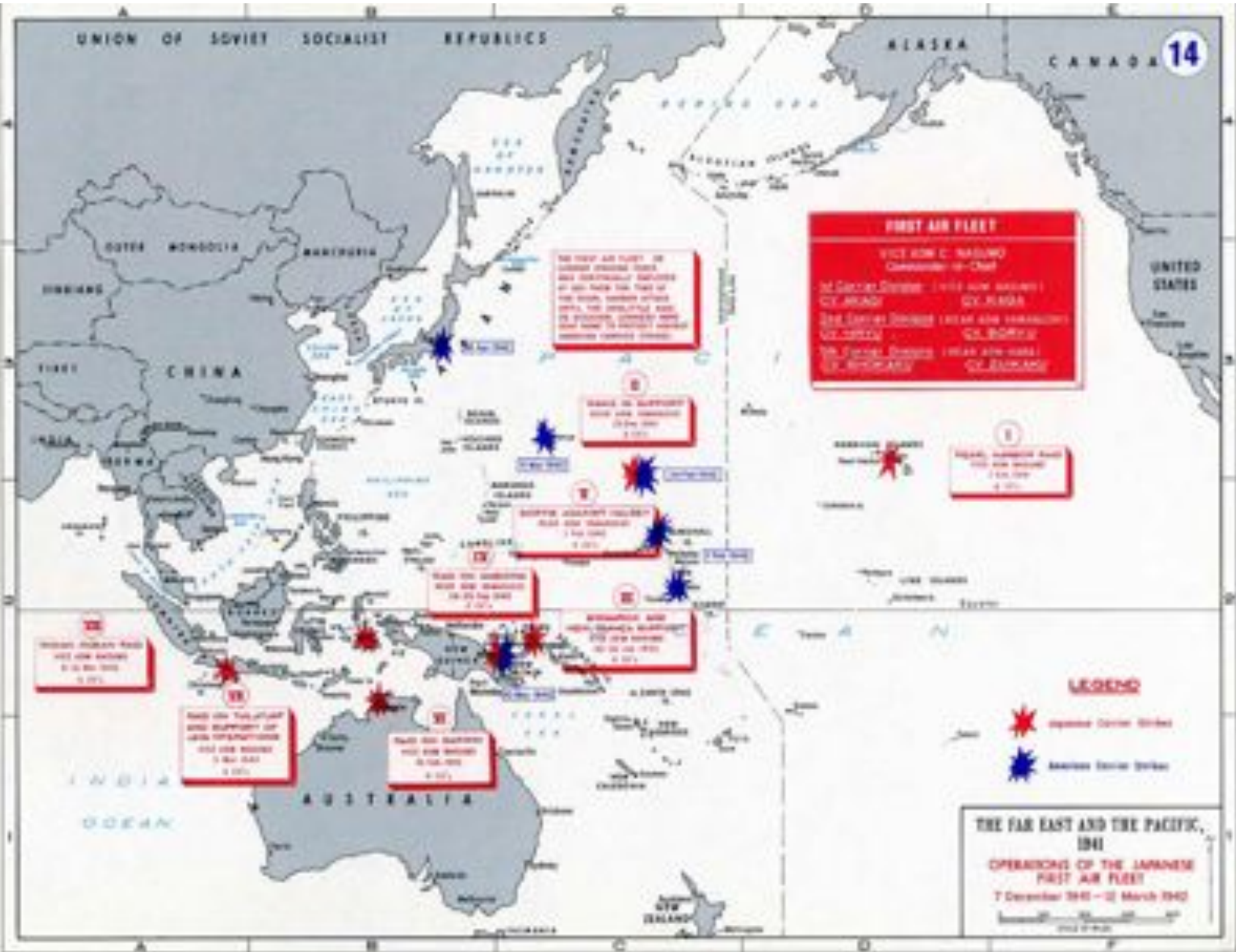

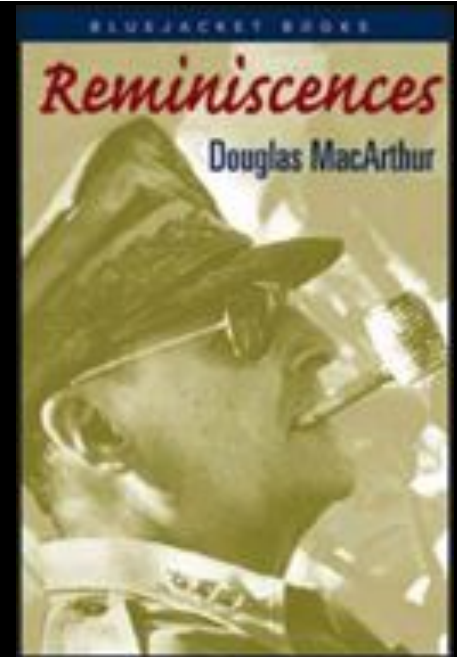

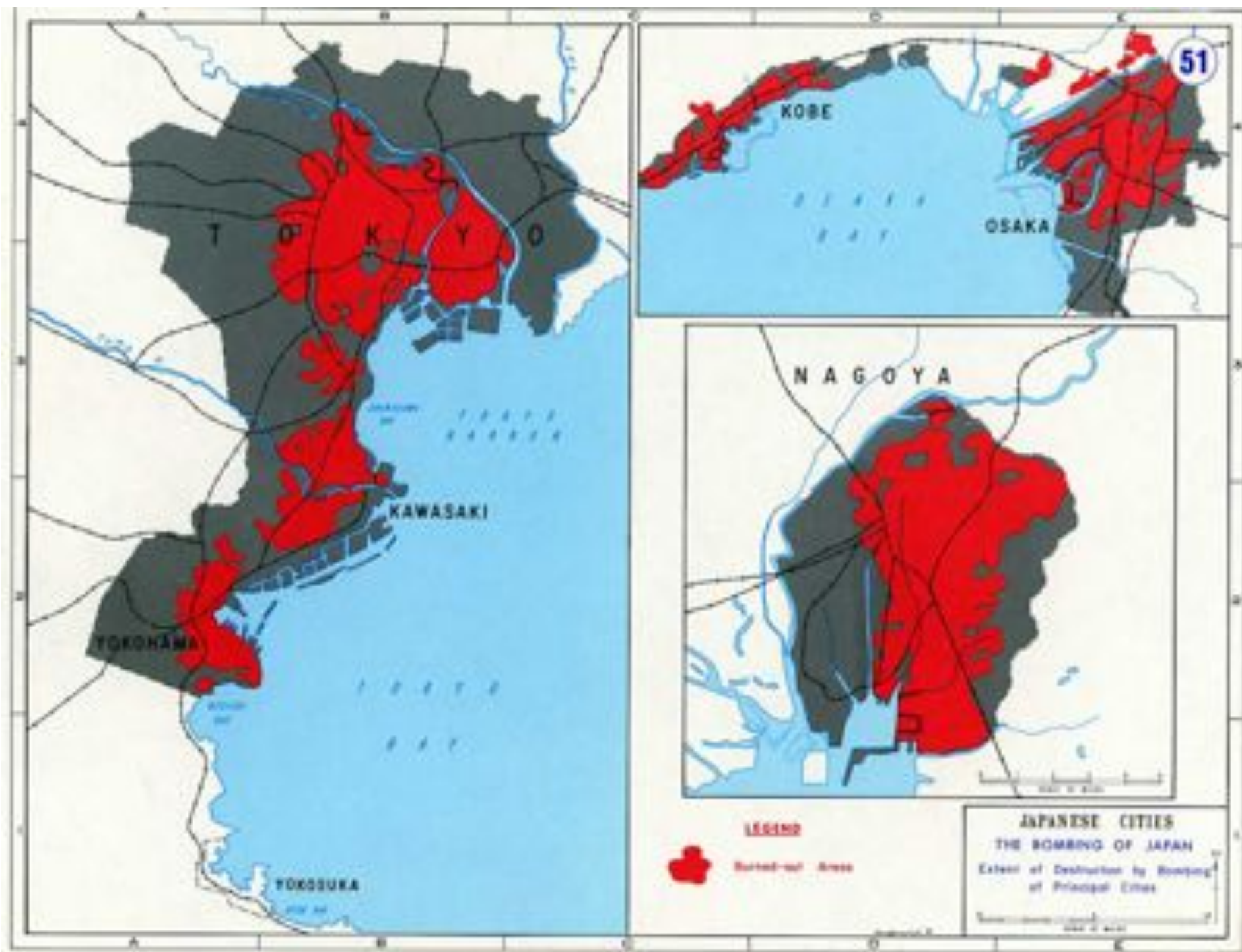

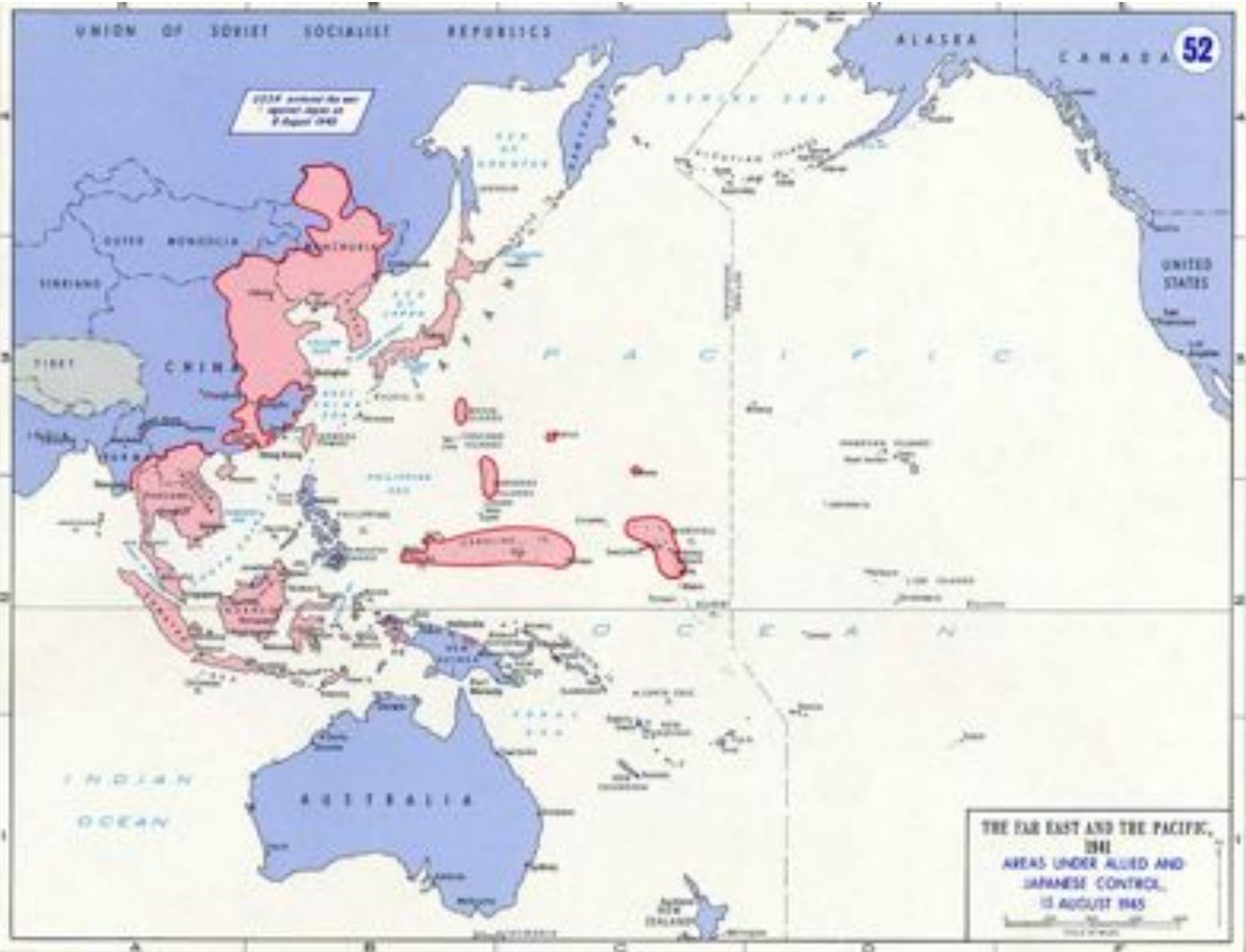
